April 29th The Sunshine Band will be here.

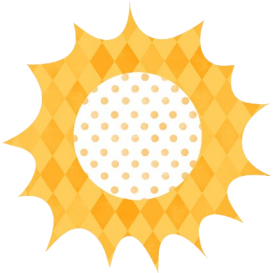
May 17th - Sonny Sinclair will be here to entertain for us.

BILLING INFORMATION REMINDER

Members are reminded that there is an annual increase of 2% on April 1 of each year.

The current fees for each group are as follows:

DAILY RATE:

Group A: \$16.88

Group B: \$16.88

Group C: \$16.88

Group D: \$19.25

Special Needs: \$19.25

DUES ONLY RATE:

Group A: \$12.38

Group B: \$12.38

Group C: \$12.38

Group D: \$14.75

Special Needs: \$14.75

Members are not charged for meals when absent from the program. However, there is a "dues only" fee in order to hold the spot for your return to the program. Members will not be charged any fee if they are hospitalized.
