


ADP Summer 2014

ATTENTION:

Members are reminded that there is an annual increase of **2% on April 1 of each year.**

The new rates as of April 1, 2014 are as follows:

DAILY RATE:

Special Needs: \$20.54

DUES ONLY RATE:

Group A \$13.07

Group B \$13.07

Group C \$13.07

Special Needs \$15.54

Entertainment – We will be singing and dancing to Elvis, John Moorehouse, Maggie Vido, Wyatt Ladd and James Anthony.


