## **Hospice to be built on St. Joseph's Villa campus**

*St. Joseph's Villa in Dundas. A new hospice is to be built on the campus.*

A six-bed residential hospice is being built on St. Joseph's Villa campus in Dundas.

The hospice, which will be based on the model of Stedman Community Hospice in Brantford, will be part of St. Joseph's Health System and supported by its leadership team.


It is scheduled to open in March 2019, noted a media release from St. Joseph's Villa.

In Ontario's 2016 budget, the province committed \$13.9 million to funding existing hospital beds and up to 20 new hospices across Ontario.

St. Joseph's Villa expects to receive \$630,000 annually from the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care to support the nursing component of the hospice, the release said.


The hospice will also be supported by St. Joseph's Villa Foundation and community contributions, which will be used toward the construction of the hospice and ongoing operational costs for programming and services.

On April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017, Liuna Station in Hamilton Ontario will be draped in RED for Canada's 150<sup>th</sup> birthday.
